Ordinance No. 48 2022

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT TO PROVIDE FOR GARBAGE AND OTHER WASTE COLLECTION FOR THE CITY OF NORWOOD FOR CALENDAR YEARS 2023, 2024 AND 2025, AS WELL AS OPTION YEARS FOR 2026 AND 2027, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Norwood's current contract, providing for the collection of garbage and other waste throughout the City of Norwood will soon expire;

WHEREAS, in order to comply with Ohio law, the City of Norwood will need to advertise for bids to enter into a contract to provide for the collection of garbage and other waste throughout the City of Norwood; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the collection of garbage and other waste throughout the City of Norwood for the years 2023, 2024 and 2025, as well as options for years 2026, and 2027, and to enter into a contract with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Service-Safety Director.

SECTION 2. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and the City Treasurer is authorized to pay warrants in the amounts stated in the contract out of the **REFUSE COLLECTION FUND 51**.



This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to proceed forthwith to avoid any disruption of garbage and other waste collection services.


