



Ordinance No. 13 2021

ORDINANCE PROMOTING THE "CITY WIDE STREET SALE" MAY 14th and 15th, 2021, AND ABATING ALL PERMIT FEES ASSOCIATED WITH THE SALE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council desires to promote a semi-annual "City Wide Street Sale" to be held on Friday May 14, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 5 :00 p.m. and Saturday May 15, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and to have all permit fees associated with this sale abated; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The City of Norwood will have a "City Wide Street Sale" on Friday May 14, 2021, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Saturday May 15, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

SECTION 2. Council for the City of Norwood hereby directs the Clerk of Council to advertise the "City Wide Street Sale" by postings throughout the City and on Norwood Cable Television in order to notify residents of this event.

SECTION 3. Norwood City Council hereby authorizes the abatement of all permit fees associated with the "City Wide Street Sale" in order to promote participation in this semi-annual event.

SECTION 4. The City will prepare a directory showing the location of all sellers in the "City Wide Street Sale."

SECTION 5. Street sale sellers who obtain their permits seven days prior to the "City Wide Street Sale" will have their addresses included in a City directory of street sale locations. This does not prevent participants from obtaining a permit after the seven-day deadline, but sellers who miss the deadline will not be included in the directory.

SECTION 6. Council for the City of Norwood hereby authorizes each residence to have a yard sale in the front yard, side yard and/or back yard on Friday May 14, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Saturday May 15, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

SECTION 7. There will be no rain out dates scheduled to replace May 14th and 15th, 2021.

SECTION 8. No home sale/street sale shall be conducted by the same resident or member of his or her family and/or the same residential property more than twice in a twelve-month period.

SECTION 9. No home sale shall offer any merchandise for sale that has been purchased by the resident for purposes of re-sale at such home sale. Any new merchandise offered for sale shall be prima-facie evidence of merchandise purchased by the resident for re-sale at such home sale.

SECTION 10. Whoever violates or fails to comply with any provision of this ordinance, shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

SECTION 11. It is highly recommended to follow the Ohio Department of Health Directors' Orders regarding the use of facial coverings and social distancing during this activity.



This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is to have time to advertise, publish a list of addresses, and give the public time to get their free permits.


