Ordinance No. 42 2020

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF NORWOOD TO ENTER INTO AN OPERATIONS AGREEMENT WITH THE NORWOOD CITY BOARD OF HEALTH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 3709.36 provides that the Board of Health (“BOH”) “shall be a body politic and corporate” which seems to prohibit the BOH from being a department of the City; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 3709.22 provides that the BOH perform certain duties and the BOH's financial reports must reflect the cost of these duties and the services provided; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The City of Norwood, by the Safety-Service Director, is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with the BOH, which shall clarify and establish the relationship between the City and the BOH as a separate entity. The Agreement is attached as Exhibit A.



This ordinance shall be declared an emergency and a measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its enactment. The reason for the emergency is the immediate need to clarify and establish the relationship between the City and BOH.




