ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SOME NORWOOD RESIDENTS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF FLORAL AND HUDSON AVENUES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, some residents ("Residents") of the City of Norwood have approached the City asking to construct a "Micro Park" ("Park") on the southeast corner of the intersection of Floral Avenue and Hudson Avenue, within the City's right-of-way in the tree lawn between the sidewalk and Floral Avenue on the western portion of 2301 Hudson Avenue, using privately-raised funds; and

WHEREAS, the Eismere Subdivision, Plat Book (P) 8-V2, Page 36, of the Hamilton County Records, dedicated in 1889, depicts and describes the City right-of-way on both the east and west sides of Floral Avenue to be used for floral beds; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 735.02 vests authority in the director of public service to manage municipal parks; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The City of Norwood, by its Director of Safety-Service, is hereby authorized to enter into the Agreement with Residents for the improvement and maintenance of the City right-of-way at the southeast corner of Floral Avenue and Hudson Avenue, appended to this Ordinance as Exhibit 1.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be declared an emergency and a measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its enactment. The reason for the emergency is the immediate benefit to proceeding with the improvement and maintenance of the City right-of-way on the southeast corner of Floral Avenue and Hudson Avenue, as a Micro Park.


