Ordinance No. 27 2020

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT TO REROOF THE NORWOOD FIRE DEPARTMENT BUILDING AT 4725 MONTGOMERY ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the roof on the Norwood Fire Department Building at 4725 Montgomery Road, has deteriorated over the decades to the point that an elaborate system of sheeting and buckets is being used to route and contain rainwater which has passed through multiple leaks in the roof, and

WHEREAS, the City Administration recognizes the need to reroof the building, to keep the firefighters, paramedics, and non-uniformed personnel who work in that Building as safe and dry as possible, and has recommended that the building which houses the Fire Department be re-roofed, without delay; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Safety Service Director is hereby authorized to advertise for bids to replace the roof system of the Norwood Fire Department Building at 4725 Montgomery Road, in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the office of the Safety Service Director and to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder to perform the reroofing, as specified.

SECTION 2. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay warrants for the foregoing purpose from 01-0842-7600, GENERAL FUND, FIRE DEPARTMENT CAPITAL PROJECTS.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to rapidly replace the roof system to limit the possibility of further deterioration of the Norwood Fire Department Building, and to maintain the building in a manner which allows it to continue to house the personnel, equipment, and operations of the Norwood Fire Department for years into the future.




