Ordinance No. 31 2020

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY-SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT, UNDER THE HOUSTON GALVESTON AREA COUNCIL (H-GAC) COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, WITH 911 FLEET & FIRE EQUIPMENT FOR THE FINANCING AND PURCHASE OF A 2021 SEAGRAVE FIRE ENGINE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Norwood Fire Department needs to replace a Seagrave fire engine which, having been placed into service in approximately 1990, has become unreliable after its approximately 30 years of service, in order to better protect people and property in the City from fire damage; and to provide its fire fighters with the fire suppression equipment which they need to provide fire safety; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has made contact with 911 Fleet & Fire Equipment, 11 Lendale Drive, Florence, Kentucky 41042 to arrange for the City's purchase of a 2021 Seagrave fire engine, for \$659,952.00, through the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) cooperative purchasing program, as authorized by Ohio Revised Code §9.48, including vehicle construction, delivery, lettering, the H-GAC purchase participation fee, two intakes, and two straight 2.5" outlets for the rear, with an expected building and outfitting time of one year, a purchase price which will expire on June 26, 2020, after which the Fire Department expects the purchase price for such a 2021 Seagrave fire engine to increase significantly; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Safety-Service Director is authorized to enter into a contract with 911 Fleet and Fire Equipment, under the Houston Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) cooperative purchasing program, for the purchase of a 2021 Seagrave fire engine, furnished and outfitted as described above, for \$659,952.00, for the Norwood Fire Department, which shall be financed through an Agreement with Republic First National Corporation of Rochester, Indiana, at an annual percentage rate (APR) of 3.09%, a total of \$722,456.80 including interest, with five equal annual payments by the City, as follows:

Payment in May, 2021:	\$144,491.36
Payment in May, 2022:	\$144,491.36
Payment in May, 2023:	\$144,491.36
Payment in May, 2024:	\$144,491.36
Payment in May, 2025:	\$144,491.36

SECTION 2. The Auditor is hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, any and all financing agreements, to obtain financing for the purchase, or other documents memorializing the City of Norwood's purchase of the fire apparatus described above. The Council further authorizes each City official, whose signature is necessary, on behalf of the City, to properly execute any lease-purchase agreement and any other

documents necessary to accomplish the financing and purchase of the 2021 Seagrave fire engine, to provide his or her signature on the lease-purchase agreement and those financing and ancillary documents, including, but not limited to signatories for the Council to prove the adoption by the Council of this Ordinance. The Safety Service Director is further specifically authorized to sign an Intralocal Contract for Cooperative Purchasing with Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) as needed.

SECTION 3: The City Auditor is authorized to draw, and the City Treasurer is authorized to pay, warrants in the amounts and according to the terms described in Section 1, for the lease-purchase of the 2021 Seagrave fire engine, out of the **GENERAL FUND 01**.



This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, to avoid a likely price increase to this fire apparatus within the next few months, and to assure the reliability of the City's fire apparatus when called into service.


