Ordinance No. 21 2019

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE EGOV COMPUTER SPECIALIZED ACCOUNTING SOFTWARE AND TO ENTER AN AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE FOR TRAINING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the purchase of eGovProfessional specialized accounting software and the provision of training of City officials and employees in that training, is necessary to enable the Auditor's Office, and other City offices, to most efficiently access and evaluate a greater amount of government data and to provide information to City elected officials, employees and citizens, as well as to access records necessary to the performance of regular business in a more timely and efficient manner, including, for example, utility services billing by the City Water Department; and,

**WHEREAS**, based partly on the City's use of prior versions of eGovProfessional specialized accounting software, which have now become functionally obsolete, the Service-Safety Director and the City Auditor have determined that this eGovProfessional accounting and billing software and training is the most beneficial to the City of Norwood; and,

**WHEREAS**, Software Solutions, Inc. has the requisite software and training services available for sale at the prices quoted on the attached quote documents #SSIQ5736, incorporated herein and marked as Exhibit A, now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1.** That Norwood City Council hereby authorizes the Service-Safety Director to enter into an Agreement consistent with the terms set forth in Exhibit A hereto, to purchase the eGovProfessional software and to agree to training services for City officials and employees, from Software Solutions, in an amount not to exceed \$170,000.00, which amount shall be drawn from THE GENERAL FUND (01) in an amount not to exceed \$131,000.00 and from THE WATER FUND (50) in an amount not to exceed \$39,000.00.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency ordinance and a measure for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the need for the Auditor's Office and other City offices to begin using this specialized accounting software, and to be trained on the use of this specialized accounting software forthwith.


