Ordinance No. 1 _____ 2022

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE SLANE AVENUE STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, WITHIN THE CITY OF NORWOOD, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council desires to help the City of Norwood benefit from outside funding to reconstruct the pavement on the entire approximate 1600 LF length of Slane Avenue, including milling and overlaying (surface and intermediate) full depth pavement repairs, curb removed and replaced, driveway aprons, curb ramps, utility adjustments and catch basins, Slane Avenue being approximately 36' wide (reduces to 30' wide at Floral Avenue) \$466,000.00 of the project, which is the estimated full cost of the project, will be funded by an Ohio Public Works Commission Grant and Loan; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Safety-Service Director is hereby authorized to advertise for bids, and enter into a contract with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, for the Slane Avenue Street Project, including any alternate bid items, pursuant to plans and specifications on file in the office of the Safety-Service Director.

SECTION 2. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay warrants, if any, for the foregoing purpose out of FUND 02-0852-57600 STREET MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR FUND.


SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to begin construction scheduled to begin March 1, 2022, with completion by September 20, 2022, a street improvement project that improves the health and safety of the City of Norwood, by benefitting from the OPWC grant and loan funding currently available.


