Ordinance No. 8 2022

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ACCEPT AN H2OHIO DRINKING WATER GRANT FROM THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY NOT TO EXCEED \$348,000.00 TO REPLACE CONSUMER-SIDE LEAD WATER SERVICE LINES ALONG THE REGENT AVENUE ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROJECT, WITHIN THE CITY OF NORWOOD, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. *as amended*

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the Safety Service Director of City of Norwood to accept an H2Ohio Drinking Water Grant from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, on a reimbursement basis to replace consumer side lead water service lines on a reimbursement basis, in an amount not to exceed ~~\$348,000.00~~;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is to authorize the alternative bid item under Ordinance No. 53-2021, to replace consumer side lead service lines along the Regent Avenue Road Reconstruction Project, for the portion of the lines that run from the residential properties to the City's connection at the street which would typically be at the expense of the property owner and would be in the range of \$6,000 per line, which grant will cover those expenses; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Safety-Service Director is hereby authorized to accept an H2Ohio Drinking Water Grant from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, to replace consumer side lead water service lines on a reimbursement basis, in an amount not to exceed ~~\$348,000.00~~ *348,000.00* for the purpose of replacing individual consumer side lead service lines along the Regent Avenue Road Reconstruction Project, for the portion of the lines that run from the residential properties to the City's connection at the street, and to sign all documents necessary to accept that grant on behalf of the City;

SECTION 2. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay warrants, if any, for the foregoing purpose out of FUND 5050-0853-57297 LEAD WATER SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to expedite the project timelines and to ensure that this grant can be used to protect the health of drinking water users living along the site of the Regent Area Road Reconstruction Project so that the project can be completed in the 2022 calendar year.
