Ordinance No. 9 20 22

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE VARELMAN AVENUE, VARELMAN COURT, AND ARKLOW COURT STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, WITHIN THE CITY OF NORWOOD, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. *is amended*

WHEREAS, Council desires to help the City of Norwood benefit from outside funding to repave the full lengths of Varelman Avenue, Varelman Court, and Arklow Court, including milling and overlaying pavement repairs, and curbs removed and replaced, as needed, with an estimated total cost of ~~\$340,00.00~~ ^{340,000.00}, with an estimated \$200,000.00 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) in funding available to offset the total cost of the project; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Safety-Service Director is hereby authorized to advertise for bids, and enter into a contract with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, for the Varelman Avenue, Varelman Court and Arklow Court Street Improvement Project, including any alternate bid items, pursuant to plans and specifications on file in the office of the Safety-Service Director.

SECTION 2. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay warrants, if any, for the foregoing purpose out of FUND ~~5~~ STREET MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR FUND (~~2005-5200-57200~~). ^{2002 57600}

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to expedite the project timelines and to ensure that this street improvement project that will improves the safety of the City of Norwood, can be completed in the 2022 calendar year.




