Ordinance No. 43 _____ 2021

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF SAFETY-SERVICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH JMA CONSULTANTS INC. TO PERFORM ENGINEERING AND DESIGN SERVICES RELATED TO THE ELM AVENUE FLOODING MITIGATION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, for many years, heavy rains have produced flooding problems on and around Elm Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City of Norwood Council desires to work quickly to eliminate any future flooding issues in the Elm Avenue area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Norwood is in need of professional engineering services for the Elm Avenue Flooding Mitigation Project; and

WHEREAS, JMA Consultants Inc. has the specialized expertise, skill, and familiarity with the problem to provide the necessary engineering and design work; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Safety-Service Director is authorized to enter into an engineering and design agreement with JMA Consultants Inc. in conformity with the terms contained in Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. The Norwood City Auditor is authorized to draw, and the Norwood City Treasurer is authorized to pay, warrants in the amounts and according to the terms of the attached Exhibit A from available funds from **FUND 8062, STORMWATER MANAGEMENT**, with supplemental funding from the **GENERAL FUND** as required not to exceed \$180,000.00, in amounts not to exceed \$180,000 in the aggregate.



The reason for said emergency is the necessity to remediate the flooding in the Elm Avenue area as soon as possible.
