ORDINANCE DECLARING THAT THE STREET CURRENTLY KNOWN AS FRANKLIN AVENUE, SPECIFICALLY THE PORTION LOCATED BETWEEN HOPKINS AVENUE AND COURTLAND AVENUE, SHALL HEREBY RECEIVE THE HONORARY, SECONDARY NAME OF "SGT. ANTHONY OVERBERG WAY"

WHEREAS, Anthony Overberg was raised in Norwood, graduating from St. Elizabeth School, attending St. Elizabeth Church, and joined the Norwood Police Department on January 16, 1941; and

WHEREAS, on July 8, 1942, having been promoted to Sergeant, Anthony Overberg was working undercover at Lawson's Drugstore at 4320 Franklin Avenue in response to a string of robberies in Norwood; and

WHEREAS, when an armed man attempted to rob the pharmacy, Sgt. Overberg struggled with the suspect, despite obvious peril to himself; and

WHEREAS, during the struggle with Sgt. Overberg, the suspect's firearm was knocked to the ground, but the suspect gained control of Sgt. Overberg's weapon, inflicting three gunshot wounds on Sgt. Overberg, before fleeing the scene; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Overberg passed away later that night; and

WHEREAS, July 8, 2022, will mark 80 years since Sgt. Overberg's Line of Duty Death, which remains the only one in the history of Norwood; and

WHEREAS, Norwood City Council now wishes to honor Sgt. Overberg's brave sacrifice, and to honor the service and sacrifice of all Norwood Police Officers, past and present; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Norwood hereby declare that the street currently known as Franklin Avenue, specifically the portion located between Hopkins Avenue and Courtland Avenue, shall hereby receive the honorary, secondary name of "Sgt. Anthony Overberg Way" by legislative action of the Mayor and City Council in honor of Sgt. Anthony Overberg and in recognition of his contributions to the City of Norwood.

SECTION 2. That the appropriate City officials are hereby authorized to do all things necessary and proper to implement the provisions of Section 1 herein, including the generation and installation of secondary street signage for the street currently known as Franklin Avenue at the intersections with Hopkins Avenue, Courtland Avenue, and Sherman Avenue in accordance with the Department of Transportation and Engineering's procedures relating to secondary street designation and related signage.

SECTION 3. Council also requests that appropriate signs be placed, and an appropriate ceremony conducted on July 8, 2022, at the intersection of Franklin and Courtland Avenues.

SECTION 4. Council declares that July 8 be recognized as Sgt. Anthony Overberg Day each year.
