Ordinance No. 73 2021

ORDINANCE DECLARING THAT MAPLE AVENUE, BETWEEN STATION AVENUE AND MONTGOMERY ROAD, SHALL HEREBY RECEIVE THE HONORARY, SECONDARY NAME OF "FIRE FIGHTER JAMES CONDRON WAY"

WHEREAS, Fire Fighter James Condron was appointed to the Norwood Fire Department on June 24, 1957; and

WHEREAS, on December 26, 1977, Fire Fighter James Condron having responded to treat a person who had overdosed on a drug of abuse, had started an intravenous (IV) line, when the patient became agitated and withdrew his arm, causing the IV needle to become dislodged and to penetrate Fire Fighter Condron's right hand; and

WHEREAS, the patient, who was Hepatitis B positive, passed that disease on to Fire Fighter Condron, who spent the next six years in and out of the hospital being treated for complications from Hepatitis B; and

WHEREAS, on January 24, 1981, Fire Fighter Condron retired from the Norwood Fire Department on a service-related disability, mainly due to ongoing issues with the disease; and

WHEREAS, on October 16, 1984, Fire Fighter James Condron, who had lived at 2577 Irving Place, died from complications from Hepatitis B, at age 54, leaving behind his wife, Anna Mae, and three children, Cathy Maureen and Timothy; and

WHEREAS, because of Fire Fighter James Condron's illness, significant changes were made to prehospital treatment, the use of personal protective equipment (PPE) and the recommendation that all healthcare workers get the Hepatitis B vaccine; and

WHEREAS, Norwood City Council now wishes to honor Fire Fighter James Condron's brave sacrifice, and that of his family, and to honor the service and sacrifice of all Norwood Fire Fighters, past and present; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1. The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Norwood hereby declare that Maple Avenue, between Station Avenue and Montgomery Road, shall hereby receive the honorary, secondary name of "Fire Fighter James Condron Way" by legislative action of the Mayor and City Council in honor of Fire Fighter James Condron, and in recognition of his contributions to the City of Norwood.

SECTION 2. That the appropriate City officials are hereby authorized to do all things necessary and proper to implement the provisions of Section 1 herein, including the generation and installation of secondary street signage for Maple Avenue between Station Avenue and Montgomery Road, in accordance with the Department of Transportation and Engineering's procedures relating to secondary street designation and related signage.

SECTION 3. Council also requests that appropriate signs be placed, and an appropriate ceremony conducted on October 16, 2022, at the intersection of Maple Avenue and Montgomery Road.


SECTION 4. Council declares that October 16 be recognized as Fire Fighter James Condron Day each year.




