Ordinance No. 76 2021

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH LOCAL UNION #445 OF THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS, CONSISTENT WITH THE TERMS OF THE ATTACHED EXHIBIT A, FOR THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1, 2022 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2024, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the negotiating committee for the City of Norwood and Local Union #445 of the International Association of Fire Fighters (“the Fire Fighters”) have negotiated a Collective Bargaining Agreement for the Contract Period from January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2024, which has resulted in a tentative agreement; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and Safety-Service Director are hereby authorized to enter into a Collective Bargaining Agreement with Local Union #445 of the International Association of Fire Fighters (“the Fire Fighters”) have negotiated a Collective Bargaining Agreement for the Contract Period from January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2024, in accordance with the terms set out in the attached Exhibit A, made a part hereof by reference.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to proceed forthwith to replace the current Collective Bargaining Agreement, which expires December 31, 2021.


